KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. SUPPORTER RELATIONS (50%)
 - welcome, thank and engage with new and potential supporters/donors via phone, email and post
 - support, nurture and develop relationships with our committed givers
 - work with Community Engagement Lead to support and deliver our appeals, and where appropriate to contact potential donors
 - work with trip participants before and after trips to ensure they are given opportunities to fully engage with and support our work
 - support individuals involved in community and faith-based groups to talk about the work of Amos Trust and encourage financial support from these groups.

2. SUPPORT FUNDRAISING AND PROFILE-RAISING EVENTS (25%)

- support the Community Engagement Lead to deliver events such as Run The Wall, Women For Women, Christmas events etc.
- assist in delivering the event logistics and contact those taking part to ensure participants have the correct resources and appropriate support before during and after the event
- maximise the fundraising generated by our work with artists, musicians and writers
- work with the Community Engagement Lead and volunteer teams to deliver the annual fundraising dinner
- ensure the correct resources and merchandise are at Amos events and represent Amos at such events
- support and work with Community Engagement Lead to ensure the smooth running of visits by international partners to the UK (central to which is providing excellent levels of hospitality); and to maximise supporter engagement and fundraising secured by the visit programme.

3. SUPPORT CHALLENGE EVENTS (25%)

- support and thank individuals organising their own fundraising activities, taking part in challenges, holding FB birthday fundraisers or similar
- support participants taking our challenge places
 e.g. Royal Parks and London Marathon
- ensure participants have the correct resources and are supported and thanked appropriately before during and after the event
- ensure that people involved in Amos' challenge events are on our donor base and signed up for ongoing communications (within GDPR rules).

You will need to develop a knowledge and commitment to Amos' three areas of work and to our vision of promoting justice and hope.

We anticipate that there will be the opportunity to visit one or more of our international partners in the future.

As Amos has a small staff team you will from time to time need to undertake other tasks as commensurate with the nature of this post.
